Building capacity in plant protection – Integrated Pest Management

In collaboration with NGIQ, the Queensland Department of Agriculture (DAF) will deliver a workshop on how to prevent pests from damaging crop using IPM. This workshop is funded by the nursery levy, DAF and Hort. Innovation.

DAF entomologists and pathologists will present an informative workshop designed for production nurseries to assist nursery producers build capacity in the area of integrated pest management (IPM). A range of topics will be covered, including:

- using IPM to protect plants from key pests
- how to modify crop production to reduce pest pressure
- how to use pesticides within an IPM program
- the physiology behind pesticide mode of action

- how to effectively manage pesticides to reduce resistance
- new biological control agents for production nurseries
- how to identify key pests and beneficials
- getting the most out of industry resources, e.g. the nursery FMS

- Sticky traps with insects you want to identify
